LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AS REQUIRED BY THE "OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT AND REGULATIONS"

Further to that at least one (1) Worker and one (1) Management member of the Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) must have completed Part One and Part Two Certification Training by a WSIB Authorized Training Provider.
